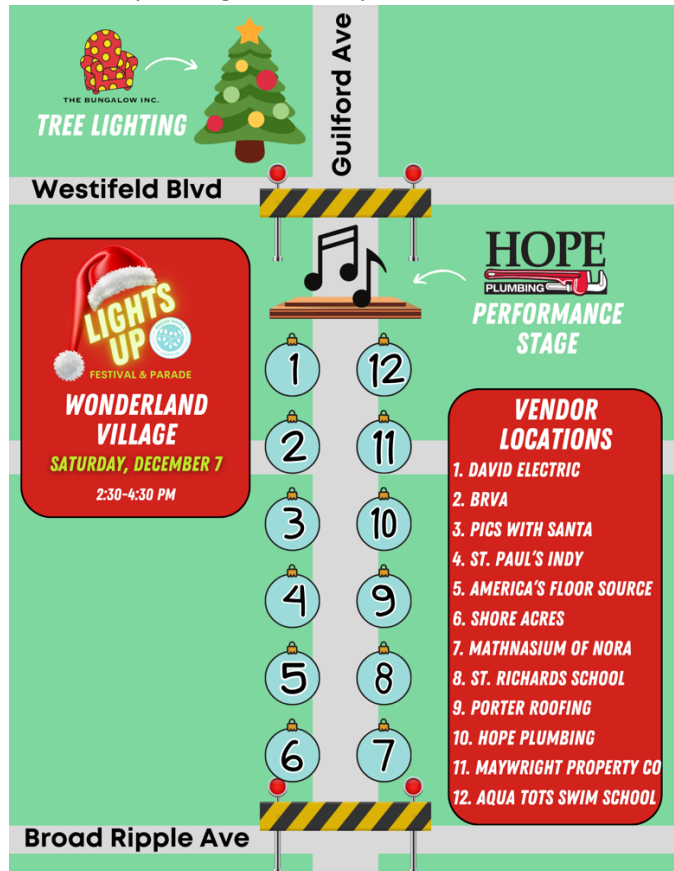
WONDERLAND VILLAGE

Event Time – 2:30 – 4:30 pm

Closed Streets - Guilford Ave between Broad Ripple Ave and Westfield Blvd from 12:30pm - 6pm

Parking Meters Closed – All meters on Guilford Ave between Broad Ripple Ave and Westfield Blvd will be bagged starting early morning on Saturday, December 7. There will be no parking or vehicular access allowed in this area from 12:30pm-6pm.

Event setup to begin at 12:30pm. Event hours are 2:30-4:30. Load out after Parade ends from 5:30-6pm.





TWILIGHT PARADE

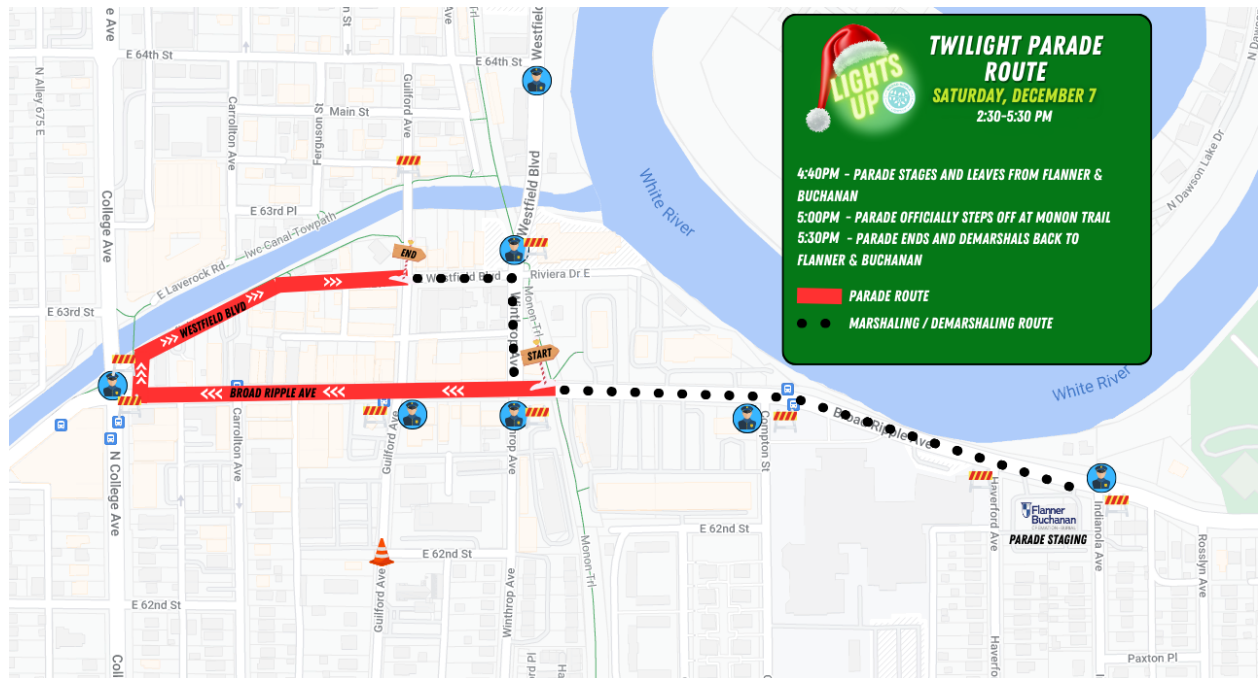
EVENT TIME – 5:00 – 5:30 pm

Closed Streets – All closures will be rolling closures as the parade moves through the Village

- Broad Ripple Ave from Indianola to College
- Westfield Blvd from College to Westfield
- Winthrop between Westfield and Broad Ripple Ave

At 4:40 parade units line up on Broad Ripple Ave at the Monon Trail. At 5:00 the parade officially steps off at the Monon trail and will travel west on Broad Ripple Avenue. The route will turn north at College and continue east on Westfield Blvd. The parade officially ends at Westfield Blvd and Guilford around 5:30pm.

Parking Meters Available – All meters on Broad Ripple Ave between the Monon and College Ave and on Westfield form College to Winthrop will be available on Saturday, December 7. However, vehicular access will be extremely limited during the parade so cars may have to wait until after the parade to leave their spot.
